

RBSA Board/Coaches Meeting 3/5/09 Minutes

Meeting called to order by Dave J. at 7:05 pm.

In attendance: All board members and multiple coaches, parents and members of the community.

Motion passed to approve February minutes.

Softball area head: Brandi reported at last county meeting team registrations were completed, fees were collected, rule books were distributed and use of the softball county website was discussed. Todd will get coaches emails from Brandi and distribute handouts to coaches that will be useful during season.

Baseball area head: Steve G. reported team waivers are due by 3/31. Invitational tournament meeting at OCHS is 4/1 at 7:30. County fees and team cards are due 4/5. The mandatory coaches' meeting is 4/15 at Alder Creek Middle School Cafeteria at 7:00. Penalties may be assessed if the coach does not attend. See www.ccjba.org for invitational tournament schedule. There is a proposal at the state level to develop a Scholarship through fees collected at the tournament meeting. See Steve G. for details.

Treasurer's Report: Rebecca reported as of 3/5 approximately \$20,787 in account after registration.

Please fill out coach's application and background check and get to Dave J. ASAP. Equipment deposit is \$150, Team fees are \$250; this is for ALL teams except t-ball. There are some raffle tickets left over from registration, if anyone wants more tickets to sell please see Dave J. Tickets need to be turned in prior to drawing at jamboree. See Cyndi Harris to schedule your practice times. Field day is April 4th. Any donations of dirt and/or sand would be appreciated.

Softball update: Todd, Brandi and Dean reported RBSA will have one team each at 8U, 10U, 12U and 16U. There were too many players for the 12U team. RBSA tried to get more players and a second coach. Some players may go to OC, RBSA tried many alternatives to accommodate all players. 10U is waiting on OC tryouts to finalize roster. Dean inventoried uniforms, 12U and 16U uniforms are ok to use for 2009. RBSA will purchase a 10U set and an 8U set as discussed in earlier meetings. Dean also inventoried softball equipment and will incorporate check in/out form. Brandi to assure SB coach contact info is correct for Dean.

Apparel sales at assessments: Michelle reported sales of approximately \$1300 (\$788 on visa) Transaction fee was about \$31.
